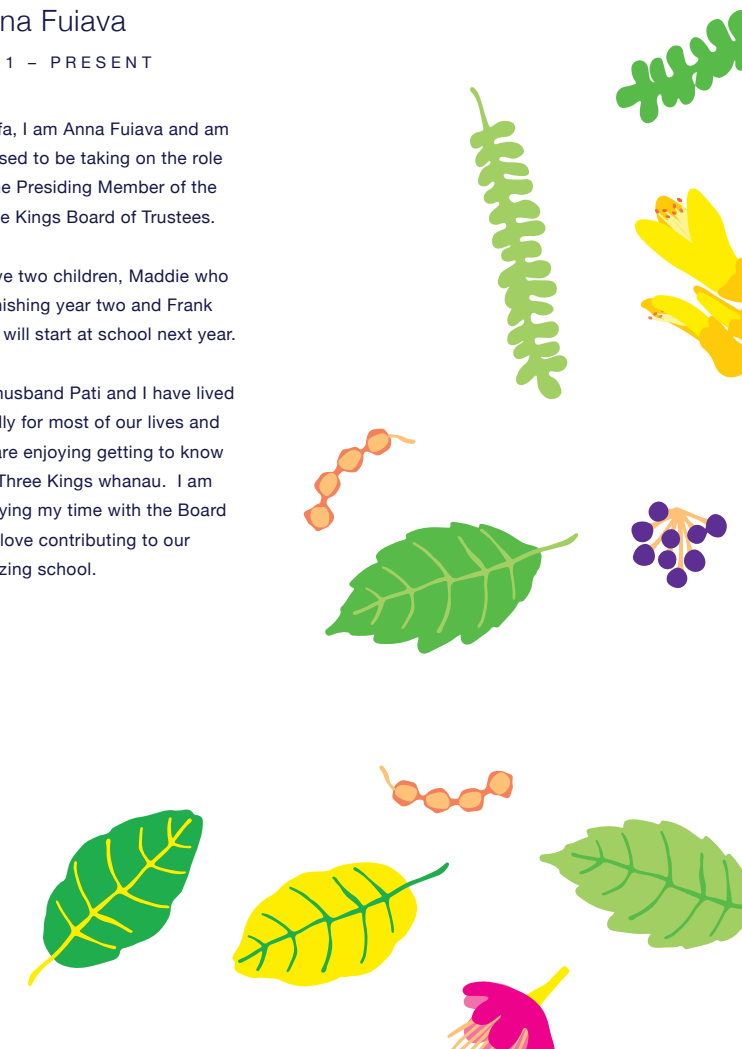
Anna Fuiava

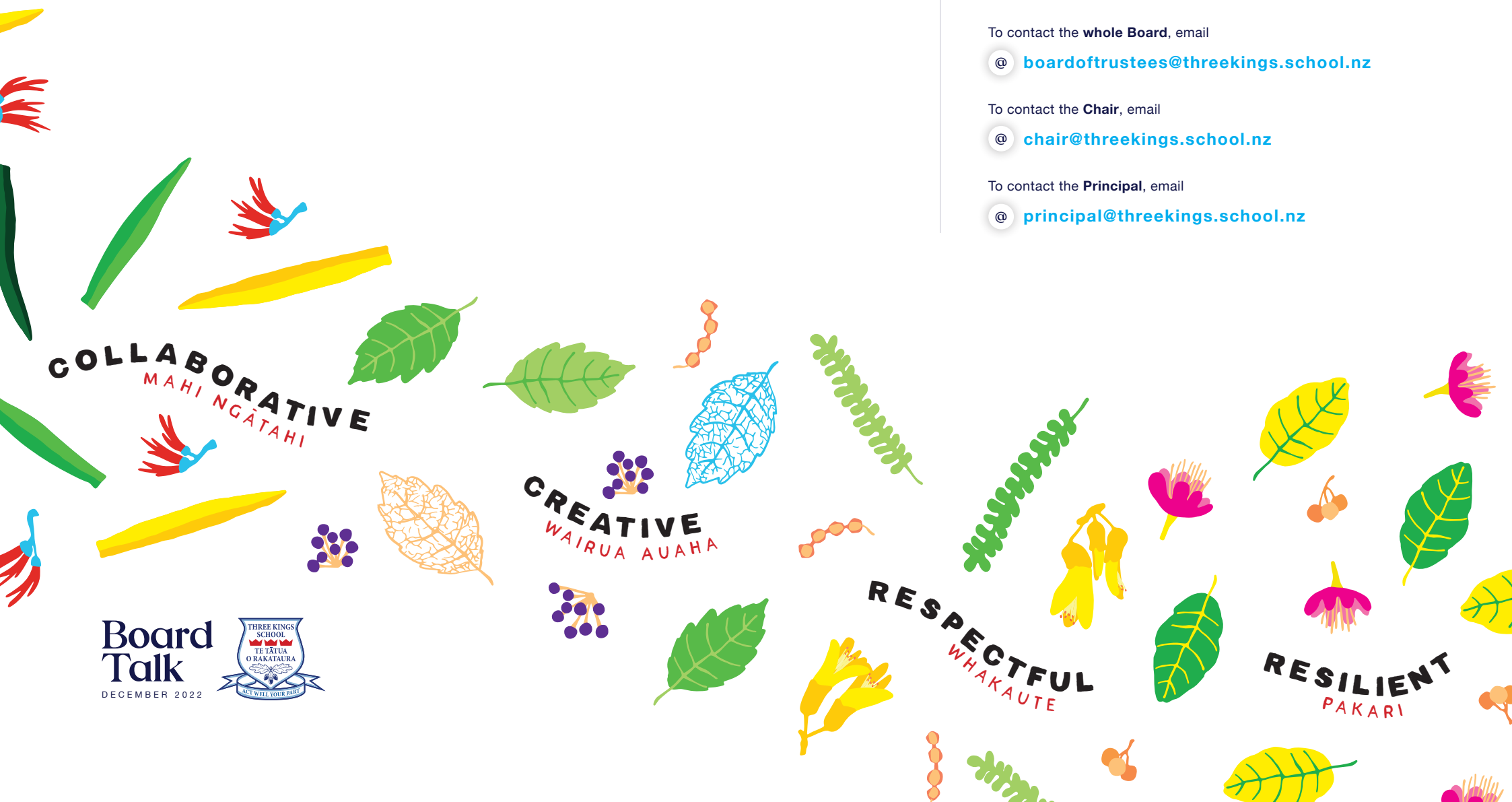
2021 - PRESENT
